If you use the last option, please reach out to us to let us know to look out for your application.
2. In addition to the application, we ask that you send us your two most recent report cards, along with the Rebbi and Menahel report forms that come with the application.
3. A \$75 non-refundable application fee should be sent as well (to be applied towards tuition should you join us).
4. Next, you can expect a phone call from us to arrange a farher and to discuss with you or your parents which gemara you should prepare for your farher. Please note that local Cincinnati talmidim must also have an interview at the Mesivta.
5. On your interview day, you and your parents can tour the Mesivta, you will be offered to experience a ninth-grade shiur for a day, and we will be available to you for any questions that you might have about the Mesivta.
6. Please have this application submitted no later than the first day of Chanuka.
